



United to Secure a Just Climate Future for All

The Platform for a Just Climate (formerly known as the Equitable & Just National Climate Platform/EJNCP) is a coalition that was formed in 2018 to address the historic exclusion of environmental justice¹ (EJ) groups from national climate change policy discourse. EJ groups and national environmental organizations from across the country united around a shared commitment to ending the environmental racism that has left economically disadvantaged communities, Indigenous communities, Black communities, and communities of color exposed to disproportionate levels of toxic pollution and bearing the brunt of the climate crisis.



The Platform for a Just Climate works toward the goals of economic, racial, climate, and environmental justice to improve the health and well-being of our communities, while tackling the climate crisis.

Together, we hold a commitment to advocate for a bold Platform that lays out our vision, including:

- A healthy climate with clean air and water for all
- Access to affordable, pollution-free electricity, transportation and housing
- A just and equitable clean energy economy with high-quality jobs

Today, the work of the Platform for a Just Climate is led by 18 coalition members and anchored by the Center for Earth, Energy & Democracy (CEED), which plays a key role as the coalition convener.

Our collective power has enabled us to successfully advocate for unprecedented funding for EJ initiatives in communities on the frontlines of the climate crisis. Our advocacy has helped shape federal policies such as the historic Justice40 initiative and billions of dollars in EJ investments to reduce and clean up pollution, provide energy assistance, replace crumbling infrastructure, improve public health and more.²

Our coalition has stood strong for over five years around our shared vision for a just climate future – and our Platform has grown to include over 300 organizations from all over the country.
